Practical issues:

Cost: Because of limited funds, Raised Voices would welcome any contribution on the day towards costs. We recognise that people's circumstances differ and some may have large travel costs, so please don't feel any obligation. We will be very happy to see you there. The cost of putting on the event is about £500. If you feel able to contribute around £5 to £10, that would help us break even, but any amount will be welcome. Anything over will be donated to Women for Refugee Women, one of the charities that Cynthia supported. There will be collecting buckets in the Hall.
